## **Hanns-Peter Storr new Member in Postbank Board of Management**

## **Hugo Bänziger appointed to the Supervisory Board**

The Deutsche Postbank AG Supervisory Board has appointed Hanns-Peter Storr to the Board of Management of the Bonn-based bank. From March 1, 2011, he assumes the position of Chief Risk Officer (CRO). In addition, effective February 1, Dr. Hugo Bänziger was appointed member of the Postbank Supervisory Board.

Storr (51) is responsible for the worldwide credit risk management with private and business clients at Deutsche Bank Privat- und Geschäftskunden AG, where he is a member of the Board of Management. After training as Bank Officer and obtaining a degree in economics at the University of Hohenheim, the credit risk expert has exercised various functions within the Deutsche Bank Group in Germany and internationally since 1987. With the appointment of Storr, Postbank takes account of the increased requirements of risk management. For the first time, it is appointing a CRO to the Board of Management.

As a further representative of the majority shareholder, Deutsche Bank, Dr. Hugo Bänziger (55) joins the Postbank Supervisory Board. As member of the Board of Management and the Group Executive Committee at Deutsche Bank, in his function as Chief Risk Officer he is responsible there for global risk management, Treasury, Compliance and further areas.
